Principal's Message

Season's Greetings. As I write this, we have just started our "learn from home" method of education delivery. The range of confidence in teaching using technology probably varies as much as the confidence level of parents and students receiving lessons. I was very pleased with the approach taken this time compared to the spring session. Thank you to parents and students for logging in and sticking to your schedule as if you were attending school in a traditional way.

Most teachers plan to cover the same content they would if students were physically sitting at their desks at school, but there are some obvious adjustments for some courses. Teachers of "physical or hands-on" classes (such as Phys. Ed , Shop, Band, Foods, and Art) will connect with their classes during scheduled class time but will have to adjust what they normally do. As the Principal, I have confidence in these teachers and know they will do their best to keep some type of learning moving forward.

Overall, I am very relieved that we got to the end of November in a traditional setting. It did allow teachers and students a chance to form a relationship and set routines, making it easier to continue them for the next few weeks. I look at this as having 14 school days in December to manage online followed by a 2 week Christmas break. I strongly encourage all staff and students to completely get away from the books for this time to get recharged for the final January push. Unless there is a change in our situation, we will continue with online learning for the first week of January to allow everyone an extra week of "isolation" before coming back to school. I was happy that the measures we took to start the year did not allow for the transmission of Covid-19 within the school and we will continue to follow those when students return on January 11th.

One final note about Diploma Exams for our grade 12's. I will start by saying our grade 12 teachers are very proud and impressed with our Grade 12 students. As a class, they have been diligent and most of us would agree that their work ethic and resulting school marks are higher than recent years. We have been told that writing the diploma exam is optional. To be honest, most of us teachers are not happy about that because we truly believe our classes would end up above the provincial averages and would be positioned for acceptance into the post secondary school of their choice. That being said, we are telling students to check with their post secondary school to see their position on writing the diploma or sticking with their school based mark for acceptance. From our investigations, it seems most Universities and Colleges are going to accept the school based mark for entry, so the diploma mark will not be required. If this is the case, the majority of our students would stick with their school based mark and not register for the diploma exam.
