11:00 am : Cap and Gown Rehearsal

This is a **mandatory** rehearsal for all participants. At the rehearsal we will walk through the Cap & Gown ceremony so students will know all the details of entering the gymnasium, coming across the stage to receive their “diploma”, and preparing for the Cap toss. After rehearsal, Grads will receive their Cap and Gown so you can take family photos. Please be extra careful that they stay in good shape for the evening program - we do not have extras!

This is the official graduation ceremony which signifies the student has met all of the requirements to graduate with a high school diploma. Students will receive a certificate from the school (the actual diploma they receive will be sent directly to the student from Alberta Learning).

6:30 -6:45: All Graduates taking part will meet in the south hallway and align themselves in order for the march into the gymnasium as determined in the rehearsal. Masks must be worn in the gathering area and will be removed once each grad enters the gym.
