

DHS Graduation 2023 Cap & Gown Application

- 1. Participation in the Ceremony includes:
  - a. Students who have and are registered in sufficient credits for an Alberta High School Diploma.
  - b. Students must be enrolled and in a position to complete 30 credits in their grade 12 year at Didsbury High School.
  - c. Students who have passed their necessary courses from semester 1 <u>AND</u> have a mark of 45% or better in all courses required for an Alberta High School Diploma on May 21<sup>st</sup> (or the first school day after May 21st). On May 21<sup>st</sup>, students enrolled in CTS courses, off-campus courses (ex. work experience), and/or distance learning courses must be close to completing those courses.
  - d. Students who have paid or accounted for all school fees at Didsbury High School by June 5<sup>th</sup> (or the first school day after June 5<sup>th</sup>).
- 2. A preliminary list of grads who meet the above requirements will be posted on May 27<sup>th</sup>. Students who are not on the posted Grad list have one week to appeal the decision and demonstrate the criteria for Grad have been met.
- 3. The Cap and Gown Ceremony is held in late June; preferably after all diploma exams are complete.
- 4. Students are required to wear appropriate attire for Cap & Gown, which would range from semi-formal to formal clothing and footwear.
- 5. There will be a \$30 fee to take part in Cap and Gown. This fee will be included as part of your school fees and can be paid on-line or by cheque.
